Scholarships and Discounts:

There are a number of tuition benefits that you may qualify for. These will be distributed equally on the bills throughout the school year.

- **\$50** per quarter for maintaining a green card.
- **\$50** per month if a sibling is attending at the same time.
- Up to **\$1,500** of the matching funds from a summer outreach program.
- During school breaks a scholarship of \$3.00 per hour plus room/board will be given. Staying for two (2) breaks is required unless the school does not have the need.
