

Financial Arrangements 2019-20

Tuition:

The base tuition for Oklahoma Academy is **\$8,750.00** per year for domestic students, and is billed in ten (10) monthly payments from August to May.

Upon Acceptance:

Upon acceptance, a **\$286.00** (non-refundable deposit) will be billed and must be paid by the date on the invoice.

Accident Insurance: \$86.00 Entrance Deposit: \$200.00

On Registration Day:

The day of registration you will need to pay the following items:

\$875.00 (first month's tuition)

\$250.00 (non-refundable) remainder of the Entrance fee.

\$50.00 (refundable) room deposit.

\$35.00 (the first month's) technology fee

Textbooks (approximately \$150 -\$395). **Textbook fees must be paid before books are issued.**

Entrance Fee is for: Yearbook, Use of laundry machines, classroom supplies, etc.

Scholarships and Discounts:

There are a number of tuition benefits that you may qualify for. These will be distributed equally on the monthly bills throughout the school year.

\$50 per guarter for maintaining a green card.

\$50 per month if a sibling is attending at the same time.

\$50 per month if monthly bill is paid on time (by the 15th of the month). Up to **\$1,500** of the matching funds from a summer outreach program.

Additional Expenses:

Computer Fee (\$35.00/month)
Lab fee (\$25.00/semester)
Music uniform fee (\$65-\$102)
Testing fees (ACT or other)
Voice lessons \$6.00 (per month)

All other lessons must be paid directly by the student to the teacher.

Field trip expenses (entrance fees, etc.)
Graduation fee (\$25)
School pictures

Transportation

Town trips, doctor visits, to or from the airport or bus station, etc.

Transcripts (\$5.00 after the 1st)
School supplies
Property damage
Medical prescriptions
Medical treatment

The school provides the opportunity for students to participate in an assistantship/work program in the summer. This is in conjunction with approved outreach programs across the United States where Oklahoma Academy will match dollar for dollar all money earned from the program up to \$1,500. Thus a student turning in \$2,000 from approved summer outreach programs would receive at total of \$3,500 in financial assistance for the school year.

Note: the matching funds cannot be paid in cash or transferred to any other account.
